PROTOCOLS FOR STUDENTS RESUMPTION [9TH JANUARY, 2022]

- 1. All students from 100 to 500 level are expected to resume on Sunday 9th January, 2022.
- 2. Each College Officer must be on ground to receive their students and will be working with the list of students per Level, Programme, Department and College.
- 3. The Bursary Unit is expected to have a desk at the marquee to confirm payment of at least 60% of school fees.
- 4. All students are expected to have made payment of 60% of their school fees and submit a copy of evidence of payment.
- 5. Students are expected to arrive between the hours of 8:00a.m. to 10:00p.m.
- 6. All parents and students entering into the University on resumption day are expected to come in through the new main gate along the express road.
- 7. All Students age 18 years and above must present their COVID 19 vaccination record and must have taken at least one dose. However, in the event that a student is not vaccinated, a negative PCR TEST RESULT that is not more than 72 hours must be presented before clearance to the hostel.
- **8.** All Students that are less than 17 years can also take the PFIZER Bio-N-Tech and are free to present their Vaccination record for clearance.
- 9. All Students that are less than 17 years and unvaccinated must produce their RDTs report, not more than 72hours prior with evidence from a traceable laboratory (Phone numbers and email address) for authentication.
- 10. All Students must come with at least a pack of facemasks and their own hand sanitizers, which will be checked at the point of entry.
- 11. Copies of vaccine record card and test results will be made and submitted at the point of entry for further verification by the University Health Services.
- 12. Students should note that the continuous assessment tests hold from Monday, 10th to Friday, 14th January, 2022.
- 13. After resumption, no exeat will be given to any students.

At the University's New Gate

- 1. Both gates for entrance and exit must be opened for proper coordination, adequate number of security operatives should be provided.
- 2. Everyone coming in to the University is expected to wear a Nose mask. "NO NOSE MASK NO ENTRY" rule shall be strictly adhered to.
- 3. Cars are to be parked in orderly manner at the marquee car park.
- 4. Only the students are expected to come out of the car to wash their hands with soap and water while the parents/drivers remain in their cars.

At the Marquee

- 1. Strict COVID 19 protocols shall be observed by everyone.
- 2. Each student should be cleared by the Bursary Unit to have paid up to 60% of their school fees.
- 3. Each student is to submit a copy of their vaccination card or the report showing negative for the PCR/RDT) test;
- 4. Debtor students will not be allowed to go beyond the marquee;

- 5. Students with pre-existing medical conditions, who will need to keep appointments with their health care providers, should come with evidence stating the date of such appointments and submit a copy.
- 6. All students are expected to dress properly as stated in the Student Information Handbook (tinted hair, long attached hair, bushy hair, beard e.t.c. will not be allowed). Barbers and hair dressers will be on ground to ensure conformance to school rules.
- 7. No student will be allowed into the Campus after 10:00p.m.

At the Halls of Residence

- 1. The students are to wash their hands at the entrance.
- 2. The porters are expected to carry out the normal halls of residence admission procedures for the students.
- 3. Cleared students' luggage will be disinfected (the modalities for luggage disinfection will be given/organized by the Health Center).
- 4. Only students with clearance from the resumption Committee desk will be allowed into the Halls of Residence.
